USCYBERCOM CIVILIAN POSITION IMPERATIVE INFORMATION

Cyber Excepted Service Positions require:

- Direct, applicable experience demonstrating the possession of knowledge, skills, abilities, and competencies necessary for immediate success in the position.
- Qualifying experience that clearly demonstrates past experience in the application of the particular competencies or knowledge, skills, and abilities necessary to successfully perform the duties of the position, typically in or directly related to the work of the position to be filled in accordance with DoDD 8140.01 and DoDI 1400.25, Volume 3005, para 3.9.
- A probationary period in accordance with DoDI 1400.25, Volume 3005, para 3.15.

Candidates claiming Veterans Preference must:

- When requested, submit a DD-214 (Member Copy 4), or, if you are CURRENTLY serving on active duty, a statement of service from your unit which states the date you entered on active duty, the date you are separating, and the campaign medals you have received.
- Cyber Excepted Service (CES) positions apply Veterans Preference to preference eligible candidates, as defined by Section 2108 of the Title 5 U.S.C. in accordance with the procedures provided in DoD Instruction 1 400.25, Volume 3005, "CES Employment and Placement."

All USCYBERCOM Positions require:

National Security adjudication to evaluate the candidate's ability to attain and maintain a favorable suitability review and security clearance as a condition of employment. Failure to maintain security eligibility may result in termination. Other requirements include:

- Drug testing
- Security background investigation
- Fingerprints
- Counterintelligence Polygraph
- US Citizenship / Legal working age
- In-person work at Fort Meade, MD
